

Hankie Pankie Quilt

Moda's hankie fabric makes a cute and easy to sew baby quilt to treasure for many years to come.

Requirements

- 6 x Moda Tiny Tots hankie squares
- 16 x 2½" strips of assorted fabrics for around the hankies.
- Sashing: 40 cm Moda 54" (137 cm) Dottie in butter
Or 60 cm of 42" (115 cm) wide fabric.
- Border: 55 cm Moda 54" (137 cm) Story Time in Robin's Egg
Or 70 cm of 42" (110 cm) wide fabric.
- Backing and binding 2.5m (115cm)
- Batting 170 cm x 125 cm (66" x 49")

Cutting

- Note that not all hankies are exactly the same size. Most measure approx. 8½" but some are slightly smaller. Before cutting measure each hankie square and cut an even amount of seam allowance around each edge of the printed hankie so as you have a 9" square including seam allowance.
- From the assorted 2½" strips, cut for each block: 2 x 9" strips, 4 x 13" strips & 2 x 17" strips. These lengths include seam allowance.
- Cut 12 x 2½" squares for the sashing from the assorted strips.
- Sashing: Cut 17 x 2½" x 17" strips.
- Borders: Cut 5 x 4" strips from 54" wide fabric (cut 6 x 4" strips from 42" fabric).
- Binding: Cut enough 2½" strips from the remainder of the backing fabric.

Sewing the Blocks. Use a ¼" seam allowance.

1. Sew two different 9" strips to the sides of the hankie square. Press the seams towards the strips.
2. Sew two 13" strips to the top and bottom of the block. Press seams towards the strips.
3. Sew two 13" strips to the top and bottom of the block. Press.
4. Sew two 17" strips to the sides. Press.

Sashing

1. Beginning with a 2½" square, sew a row of 4 x 2½" squares and 3 x 17" sashing strips. Press the seams towards the strips. Make 3 rows.



2. Arrange the blocks in two vertical rows of three blocks.
3. Beginning and ending with a sashing strip, sew a row of 3 blocks and 4 sashing strips. Press the seams towards the sashing.
4. Repeat for the 2nd row of blocks.
5. Sew a row with small squares and sashing strips to both sides of the first row of blocks matching the small squares to the sashing strips between the blocks.
6. Sew the second row of blocks to the sashing on the right side of the first row of blocks.
7. Sew the remaining row of sashing and small squares to the right side of the second row of blocks.

Borders

1. Cut the border for the top and bottom 39½". Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press seams.
2. Join strips and cut the side borders 65". Sew to the sides.

Easy Machine Quilting

Tack or pin the backing, batting and quilt top together. Sew a straight line of quilting from the corner of the sashing square, that is in the sashing around the edge of the quilt, through the strips to the corner of the hankie square. Repeat for all corners of the hankie. Sew in the ditch around each hankie and in the ditch on both sides of the sashing.
